

Future-Readiness Course



The Beable Future-Readiness Course is comprehensive, synthesizing multiple disciplines and types of thinking. The course incorporates content and learning from a variety of areas including World of Work, Financial Empowerment, Civic Responsibility, Health and Wellness, and Personal and Workplace Empowerment.

Students explore Future-Readiness concepts through their online readings, lesson activities, and lesson extensions. In addition, throughout this year-long course they investigate and reflect on three overarching essential questions:

Being Me

What does it mean to be me?

Working with Others

What does it mean to relate to and work with others?

Making Choices

How do I apply what I know to problem solve and make decisions?

World of Work

World of Work exposes students to both self- and career- exploration in the ever-changing landscape of the global economy. Lessons are built with a focus on John Holland's Theory of Career Choice (RIASEC), which states that when people choose a career, they seek opportunities that will let them use their skills and abilities, and also express their attitudes and values. Students will read about a variety of jobs and careers to help them understand how their own personal strengths, interests, and values can connect to various career clusters and paths.

Financial Empowerment

Financial Empowerment Lessons expose students to the lifelong journey of financial decision-making and the related resources that impact their overall well-being. Students will read about and apply an array of financial skills, such as managing personal finances, saving, budgeting, spending, and investing.

Civic Responsibility

Civic Responsibility is the idea that citizens should participate in activities that benefit their community. In these lessons, students are prompted to think about their roles and duties- both small and large- as a citizen of their community. Students will read about ideas like voting and volunteering, as well as explore their responsibilities as a digital citizen.

Health and Wellness

Health and Wellness lessons cover a variety of topics, including nutrition, mental and emotional health, positive relationships, stress management, and injury prevention. There is also a focus on the relationship between health issues and the community, such as the need for community health services and the impact of environmental factors on public and personal health. In addition, students will explore internet safety and what it means to be "health literate."

Personal and Workplace Empowerment

Personal and Workplace Empowerment lessons help students build valuable knowledge, skills, and beliefs for a strong understanding of themselves and of how to reach their career and life goals. In these lessons, students will explore six overarching essential skills: Emotional Intelligence, Communication, Creative and Critical Thinking, Collaboration, Dependability, and Resourcefulness.
