



World of Work S-I-V-J Prompt Overview (Strengths, Interests, Values, and Jobs)

Learning about oneself is not a one-time event; it’s an ongoing process. This process is helped tremendously by meaningful conversations with peers, educators, and family members. To support these discussions, Beable provides a set of monthly S-I-V-J prompts.

Implementation Ideas: Classroom Level

- Create an S-I-V-J Prompt bulletin board. Ask students to write their answers to the prompts on sticky notes and post those notes to the bulletin board. Discuss the students’ answers to the prompts with the whole class. What similarities are there between the students’ responses? Differences?
 - Share your responses to the prompts too; your students should know that you also have strengths, interests, values, and job interests.
- Use the S-I-V-J prompt as a writing journal entry.
- Build culture and connection in class by having your students use the S-I-V-J prompts in a turn- and-talk exercise. Students can share their commonalities and differences in pairs, and then as a whole class.
- Use prompts as a homework exercise so students can gather responses from their family members and share those responses in class.

Implementation Ideas: School Level

- Use S-I-V-J prompts during school announcements. Post S-I-V-J prompts on your school webpage and/or social media platform.
- Add S-I-V-J prompts to family communication materials, encouraging families to discuss the prompts at home.
- Post S-I-V-J prompts in common areas of the school (such as the library, cafeteria, hallways, or office), prompting all staff members to engage students in conversations about the prompts.
